Bird Watching

Pucón and its surrounding area is the ideal place for nature lovers and bird watchers alike. With the combination of parks, lakes, rivers and mountain-tops, you will have the opportunity to see 65 different species of birds.

Pucón Birding offers four distinct locations for bird watching throughout the region: Parque Antumalal, Saltos de Carileufu, Trailenco and Nevados.



Parque Antumalal is a 5.5 hectare lakeside park with over 35 species of birds that nest on the lake shore. This native tree park and lovely floral garden surroundings are essential for the presence of birds. Antumalal (Corral of the Sun in Mapudungun) is a beautiful location from which the Bird Watcher can combine birding with nature.

Saltos de Carileufu is a short 25 minute drive from Pucón. This location is set along the river Carileufu, a branch of the Trancura River, in the midst of native forests and mountains with magnificent views of the Villarrica and Mocho Volcanoes. Here you can observe Correntine ducks, Martin fisherman and other birds, averaging about 33 different species of birds that are unable to be found on the lake shore.



Trailenco is a 20 minute drive from Pucón. It is a dormant volcano with 2 hills that overlook the Trancura and Liacura River Valleys. A 200 hectare nature forest hosts a large diversity of birds, approximately 35 species, unaffected by humans. Here you will find a lagoon where you can observe different ducks nesting with their offspring.

Nevados is a mountain over 1400 meters high and snow capped in winter. The bird population here is totally different from the previous three settings. From this location you can enjoy the view of the Lake Villarrica Valley and the imposing presence of the volcano. To the north you can see the peak of the Volcano Llama. Nevados is surrounded by young native forests assuring a healthy bird population.
